Internet safety policy

At Inverbrothock Out of School Care Club we operate an internet safety policy. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all children within our care can enjoy the internet safely and understand the dangers that can occur when browsing the internet.

We aim to keep the children safe using the internet by:

- Ensuring that the children do not access the internet without adult supervision.
- Only allowing children to use devices such as tablets and computers that are owned by the club (the children are not permitted to bring their own devices to the club).
- All devices owned by the club will have parental locks on them and will need an adult to authorise downloading of games, music etc.
- Staff being aware and have training on internet safety.
- Staff educating children on internet safety.
- Staff working with parents on internet safety.
- Children will not have access to social networking sites whilst using the internet at the club.

Children have rights and responsibilities when using the internet to enhance their learning and development using technology. Staff are committed to ensuring that these experiences are safe for children. Staff work with the children to ensure they understand the dangers that can be found online and how to deal with them. The children are actively involved in creating ways to stay safe whilst using the internet.

This policy is in place to protect all service users and staff.
